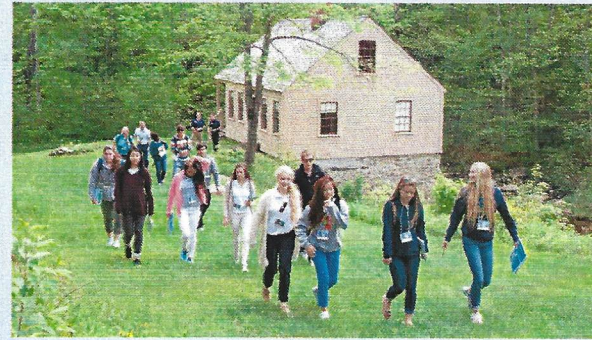


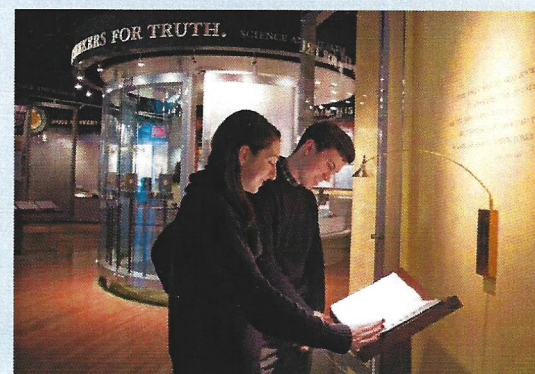
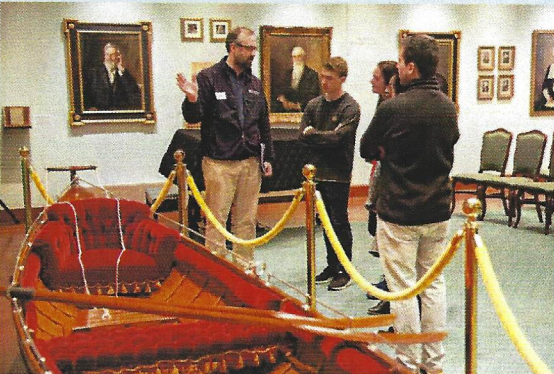
YOU ARE INVITED TO VISIT LONGYEAR MUSEUM'S

Mary Baker Eddy's story is rekindled as visitors cross the threshold to stand in the very rooms where the Discoverer, Founder, and Leader of Christian Science lived and worked. These houses are carefully preserved in Longyear Museum's permanent collection, and each one marks a stage in Mrs. Eddy's experience, from the struggles of her earlier New Hampshire years to the years of authority represented by her home in Chestnut Hill, Massachusetts.
